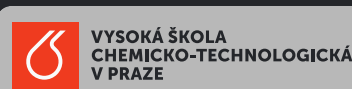

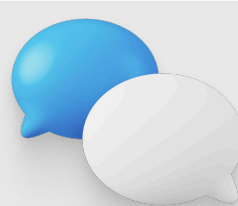

During the course, students review the entire school-level chemistry curriculum, but with one key difference — all subjects are taught in English, where many chemical elements and compounds have different names.

By the end of the course, students will be able to perform chemical calculations, accurately describe reactions, and confidently explain key terms and formulas.

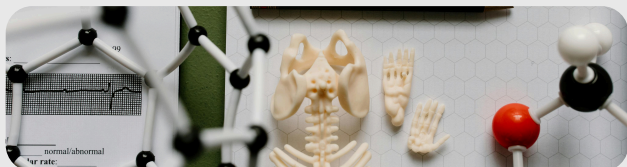

Entrance Exams & Top Medical Faculties in the Czech Republic



First Faculty of Medicine, Charles University (1. LF UK) — Prague

The oldest and most prestigious Czech medical faculty, offering top-level hospital training and strong research reputation.

Admission: Written multiple-choice test in Biology, Chemistry, and Physics, followed by an MMI interview for selected candidates.

General Medicine (6 years)

Dentistry (5 years)

€24,250 / year



Second Faculty of Medicine, Charles University (2. LF UK) — Prague (Motol Hospital)

Closely linked to Motol University Hospital, the largest hospital in Central Europe, offering extensive clinical practice.

Admission: Written MCQ test in Biology, Chemistry, Physics, and Logic (75 questions, 90 minutes).
Exams usually take place in May or June.

General Medicine (6 years)

€16,600–€17,000 / year



Third Faculty of Medicine, Charles University (3. LF UK) — Prague

Uses a modern modular teaching system with early patient contact and a friendly international atmosphere.

Admission: Written MCQ in Biology, Chemistry, and Physics (sometimes Math), followed by an interview.
Exams are held in late May with a July reserve date.

Entrance Exams & Top Medical Faculties in the Czech Republic



Faculty of Medicine, Masaryk University (MU) — Brno

Highly digitalized university with one of Europe's most advanced simulation centers for clinical training.

Admission: Written MCQ in Biology, Chemistry, and Physics.
Students can also take the online test

Faculty of Medicine & Dentistry, Palacký University (UPOL) — Olomouc

One of the most affordable and student-friendly medical faculties in the Czech Republic with strong academic standards.

Admission: Written MCQ test in Biology, Chemistry, Physics, and Logic (75 questions, 90 minutes).
Exams usually take place in May or June.

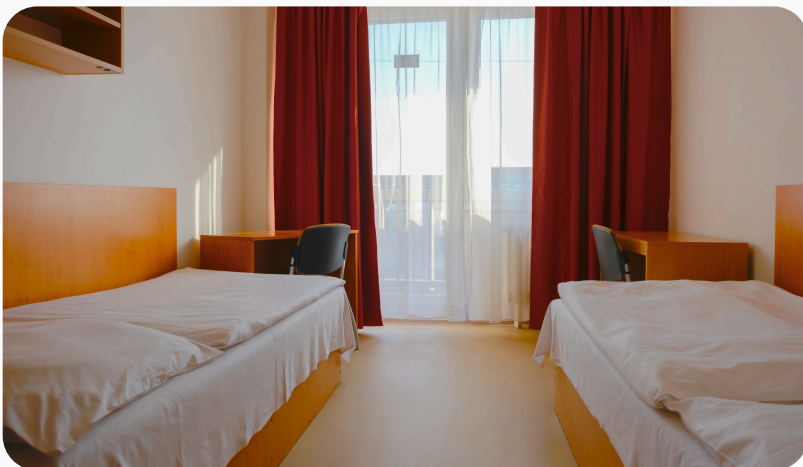
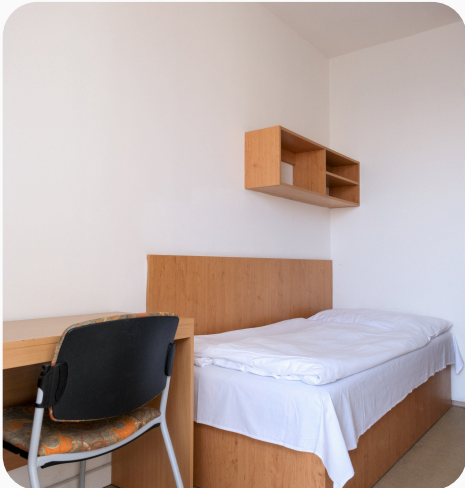

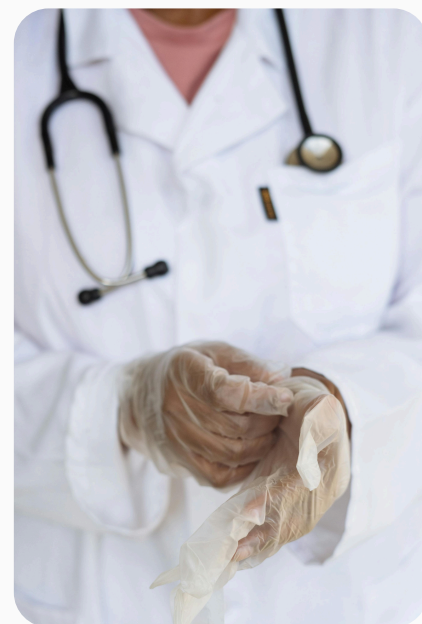
