Winter holidays in Prague 2023

10 days/9 nights (03 – 12 January)
25 hours of Czech or English

The cost of the program includes: meeting at the airport, transfer, accommodation, meals (tomorrow and dinner), a cultural program in Prague and field trips, a ticket for all types of transport, a SIM card, curatorial support.

Cultural program

Day 1:

January 3 – Tuesday

Meeting at the airport / train station by a representative of the company, **transfer** to the residence.

14.00 - CHECK IN, the beginning of registration and accommodation in the residence.

*On this day, there is **an acquaintance with the detachment and curators**. Camp participants **receive a SIM card, a travel card, and a branded gift from the school**. Depending on the time of arrival, the guys will have the opportunity **to walk around Prague, exchange money for Czech crowns**.*

Day 2:

4 January – Wednesday

Breakfast. Buffet.

Studying from 8.30 a.m. to 12.45 p.m.

Children will be divided into groups depending on the level of language proficiency. At the first lesson, the children get acquainted with a teacher who is a native speaker. There will also be an interactive thematic lesson in English or Czech.

Dinner. At the venue of the program

Guided tour of Prague

The children will walk along the main avenue – Wenceslas Square, the dominant feature of which is the National Museum and the majestic equestrian statue of St. Wenceslas. Usually, all Czechs make appointments here. Along the cobbled streets (do not forget about comfortable shoes!) you will reach the famous Staromak (as the locals call the Old Town Square). On the way, buy a trdelník cooked on charcoal - a national sweet bun, the aroma of which permeates the air of historical Prague. You will find out what is so remarkable about the Charles Bridge and where you need to make a wish. Then the participants of the walk will get to the Lesser Town and along the winding streets will get to Lesser Town Square, from there to St. Vitus Cathedral at Prague Castle. There you will have a view of the



legendary red roofs. You will understand why Prague is called the city of a thousand spires. There you will also see where the President of the Czech Republic lives and perhaps catch the changing of the guard at the palace gates.

Dinner and organizational meeting.

Day 3:

January 5 – Thursday

Breakfast. Buffet.

Studying from 8.30 a.m. to 12.45 p.m.

During the classes, you will practice speaking, play quests, watch movies in a foreign language, sing songs, perform creative work, for example, shoot short videos on various urban topics or your own clips.

Dinner.

Presentation on higher education in the Czech Republic.

Free higher education in the Czech Republic. The significance of the Czech diploma in Europe and in the world. Salaries in the Czech Republic. Opportunities for Russian-speaking applicants. We will talk about all this and much more at the presentation.

Excursion to the evening Christmas Prague.

New Year's Prague is considered one of the most beautiful world capitals. And in Europe it has no equal, so millions of tourists come here every year to feel the spirit of Christmas and visit elegant fairs. We will visit the main city Christmas tree of the country, watch a light and music performance and inhale the aroma of cinnamon in the air. To consolidate emotions, just be sure to buy trdelnik - this is a national sweet tube cooked on charcoal and hot apple juice. Then, under the reflections of evening lanterns on the Vltava River, you will stroll through the most popular youth place - the embankment. You will see the famous dancing house. Then you will reach the island of Kampa and take a selfie against the backdrop of the John Lennon wall. Count the yellow penguins near the Museum of Modern Art and fall in love with post-sunset Prague.

Day 4:

January 6 – Friday

Day 5:

January 7 – Saturday

Field trip to Dresden (Germany) for the whole day.

You will go to the capital of Saxony - a fabulous city on the Elbe. Visit the grandiose art gallery (entrance is paid separately) - and you will understand why there is so much talk around Raphael's Sistine Madonna. You will see the most beautiful dairy store in the world (the Germans even turned the dairy trade into art) and the so-called "Procession of Princes". The 100-meter porcelain panel is the largest work of art in the world. You have already understood that in Dresden everything is the very best. And the sausages here, of course, are also the longest. Compare which ones are tastier - German or Czech.

Day 6:

January 8 – Sunday

Visit to the National Museum (entrance fees included).

2000 years of the Czech state under one roof. Episodes of the film "Casino Royale" with Daniel Craig were filmed here. And recently the museum opened after many years of reconstruction for \$150 million!

Dinner. And after dinner, we suggest going to watch a movie together in the cinema or to the skating rink (the ticket is paid separately).
